



## Charles Bernard Jarrett

July 21, 1941 - April 9, 2022

Charles Bernard Jarrett was the second son born to the late John Henry Jarrett, Sr. and Josephine Jordan Jarrett. He was born in Winton, NC on Monday, July 21, 1941. Charles is survived by his brothers Lawrence A. Jarrett (Katherine) of Hampton, VA, and John H. Jarrett, Jr. (Doris) of Ahoskie, NC; his sister R. Michelle Salter (Craig) of Durham, NC; his former wife Barbara Jean Jarrett of Ahoskie, NC; his step son John Richard Hardy (Lucy) of Killeen, TX ; and a host of relatives and friends.

Charles graduated from C.S. Brown High School in 1960. Upon completion of his high school education, he attended Elizabeth City State University for two years. He was then drafted into the United States Army where he served his country. A large portion of his tour was served in Germany. After serving this nation, he chose to serve Hertford County by joining the Sheriff's Department and becoming one of Winton's favorite deputies. He loved traveling and especially enjoyed New York City. Charles had a passion for cooking where he did so at Hobson Reynolds National Elks Shrine. He was known for his pear preserves and sweet potato jacks, and he loved sharing his delicacies. He loved sports, especially football and basketball. His favorite pro teams were NFL's Pittsburg Steelers and NBA's Los Angeles Lakers, and he never forgot his UNC Tar Heels.

Most importantly, he accepted Christ in midlife and attended Jordan Grove Baptist Missionary Church until his declining health no longer allowed him to attend. On April 9, 2022, the Lord called Charles home to a place of eternal

rest, no more pain, no more sorrows, no more struggles. Rest in peace our
