Doris could be caught enjoying basketball, football, tennis, and golf, and she knew them well. She loved to travel. She took many trips with her sister Adell Williams, visiting Niagara Falls and the Grand Canyons, and many other places. She and her sister Lois Everette made it their tradition to take a yearly trip to New York.

Doris loved family and was often the life of the party. She was smart and had no problem with a quick comeback when joking. She loved singing and was a member of the Robert L. Holloman Choir, and the Gospel Choir at Nebo Baptist Church. She was also a member of the "Crystallites" Quartet, founded by friends. She enjoyed singing so much, that along with her daughter-in-law, Madie "Rita" Taylor, formed the Gospel Keys Junior. This group included her baby, Craig Reid, and her three grandsons; KK, DayDay, and Maine, as she called them.

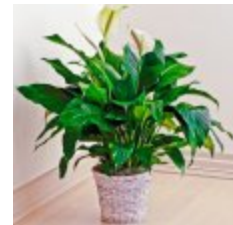

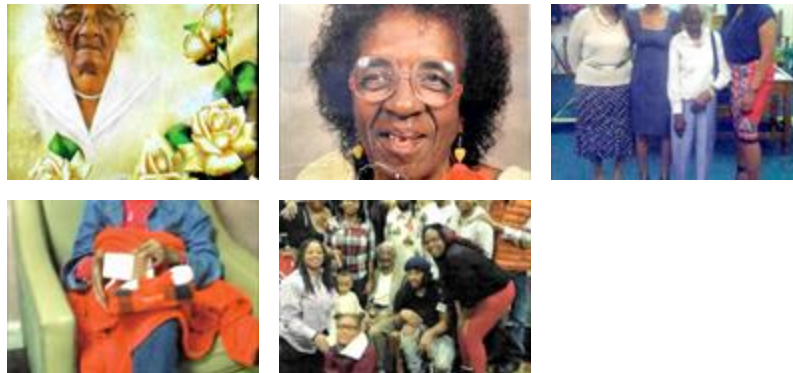
