She was the oldest child of the late John David Williams and the late Cherry Vann Williams-Alexander. Mabelle was the widow of the late Elbert "Possie" Archer who passed in October 2009. That union lovingly lasted for sixty-eight years.

Her roots were Winton, in the area of Mount Moriah Baptist Church. As a child, she was educated at home and attended The Cotton School. In that area, she spent joyous times with her childhood and lifelong friends; Mattie Vann, Nancy Ella Vann Gatling, and Beatrice Jordan Pruden. All who preceded her in passing. However, she laughed heartily when she shared with her daughters about the fun they had. For example: She and Beatrice married and moved to the big town of Winton. Mabelle joined Mount Moriah Baptist Church as a young child. As years passed, she played an active role in several axillaries: missionary, deaconess and usher board. It proclaimed her church service and attendance as the oldest active member.
