She volunteered for over fifty years at Riverside Nursing Home. She was actively involved in the Newport News Vicinity Chapter of Beauticians, the Virginia State Beautician's Association, The National Beautician Culture League, Inc, Youth for Beauty, and the Hundred Dollar Club. Everyone that knew her would know that she was an excellent cook. She was famous for her Sweet Potato Jacks and Banana Pudding. She loved to be active and was an avid bowler, sewer, golfer, loved flowers and most importantly to be a loving mother, wife and grandmother. She was a devout Christian woman of God and was a loved member at First

Church of Newport News. She later became a member of Friendship Baptist Church.
